INSTITUTIONAL POLICY FOR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AND FREESHIPS

A. Policy Statement:

Dharmasala College is located in the very rural and remote area where the large portion of the community lived under the below poverty line. With this view, Dharmasala College always seeks to achieve excellence in the myriad fields for the upliftment the locality. The Institute is looking forward to bring the academic excellence among the students fraternity by providing Scholarships and Freeships to the socioeconomic challenged students and students from reserved category SC/ST/OBC.

B. Objectives:

- 1. To assist the meritorious students coming from economically weaker sections.
- 2. To assist the SC/ST and OBC students wherever applicable.
- 3. To encourage the students to be an excellent in terms of sports, cultural and academic.
- **4.** To promote and motivate the students towards the excellence and overall development.

C. Practices:

1. Scholarship by Govt. of India

The Students may avail the scholarships provided by the Govt. of India such ISHAN UDAY through proper channel wherever applicable fulfilling all the criteria as per rules and regulations circulated by the Govt. of India.

2. Post Metric scholarships for SC, ST and OBC students as per guidelines provided by Govt. of India.

3. Freeships by the Institution:

(i) Before the provincialization of the College, the Institute has taken an incredible step towards students by offering them free admission for BA 1st Semester only in the Academic Session: 2020-2021 with the approval of Governing Body of the College.

 (iii) The Institute may extend its financial support for all round performance in academic as well as extra-curricular activities.

D. Eligibility:

- (i) Students whose parental income is less than Rs.2.00 Lakhs from all sources will be eligible.
- (ii) If either of the parent (mother/father) of the student is working in the State Govt./Central Govt./ Semi Govt./State or Central Govt. undertakings, such students shall not be eligible under fee waiver scheme.
- (iii) Fee waiver scheme is only for regular students (already admitted under the scheme) having minimum 75% of attendance in classes with no back paper/s in previous examination.
- (iv) Must produce SC, ST and OBC certificate duly signed by the competent authority.
- (v) Only those students shall be eligible to apply who satisfy all the merit criteria as per the Freeships scheme.
- (vi) Fulfill all the eligible criteria and apply through proper channel.
- (vii) Must produce an income certificate from the local Revenue Circle Officer wherever relevant.

E. Budget Allocation:

The institute will allocate budget for the financial assistance & freeships to the meritorious students to support them in each year financial assistance and freeships will be provided on subject to availability of the fund.
