


General Instructions For Dharmasala College Students' Union Election – 2025

The following guidelines on Students' Union Election are formed as per an order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 2nd December, 2005 has directed the implementation of the recommendation of the committee chaired by Sri J.M Lyngdoh (Former Chief Election Commissioner of India). Some important directions of the Hon'ble court are summarized below:

1. Voting will start from 9 A.M. and end in 2 P.M. After 2 P.M no one will be allowed to cast their vote.
2. Mobiles and camera are not allowed in Voting Booth. Use of Mobile and camera in the Voting Booth will be treated as an offence.
3. Voters are not allowed to take any sample copy of Ballot papers inside the Voting Booth.
4. No one without a valid pass from the election commission of the college shall enter the Polling Booth.
5. Impersonation and Bribing of Voters is prohibited.
6. Canvassing within 100 meters of the polling station on the day of poll is prohibited.
7. Candidates are directed not to serve or distribute any eatable items except water on polling day within the college campus.
8. All students must bring SAMARTH ID card.
9. For 1stsem students who cannot download the Samarth ID Card are asked to bring Original Admission Receipt and Aadhar Card.
10. For 3rdsem students who cannot download the Samarth ID Card are asked to bring Original Admission Receipt and Aadhar Card.
